

Student Protocol for Returning to School

Covid -19 Safety Measures

September 20

General

All children will be expected to attend as normal in September

Students will be expected to wear school uniform

Phones will be placed in a plastic bag and handed to staff upon arrival at the building entrance point

The kitchen will re- open with full school meals available. FSM vouchers will therefore no longer be

available

No use of water fountains. Students will be given a disposable cup if they need a drink of water

Transport

KCC Transport policy will be followed

Taxi will stop in the playground

Students should wait in the taxi until a member of staff directs them through the door next to the

medical room. Hand sanitizer will be used on entry to the school and items handed in.

At the end of the school day, students will collect their belongings from their form teacher and will then be individually directed back to their taxis which will be

parked in the playground.

Movement around school

Social distancing should be maintained at all times.

Students will use hand sanitiser on entry and exit to the school and throughout the school day

Students will walk on the left hand side of corridors and stairs at all times

When students move between classrooms hand sanitiser should be re applied

When using the toilet, ensure that hands are washed for at least 20 seconds. Hand sanitiser can be

used on re –entering the classroom.

There should be no physical contact with teachers or other students.

There will be no whole school gatherings such as assemblies

Cleanliness

Students should use hand sanitiser on arrival at the school and when entering or exiting a classroom

They should wash their hands for at least 20 seconds after using the toilet

Feeling Unwell

If a student feels unwell and is showing symptoms of Covid -19 they should not come in to school. The school reserves the right to send any students back home if symptoms are observed.

If they develop symptoms whilst in school they will be isolated in meeting room one and parents will

be asked to collect them

Parents of any other children who are in school that day will also be informed.

Behaviour

Parents will be expected to collect any student who refuses to follow this protocol and does not

listen to staff direction. The senior leadership team will then risk assess whether the student is able

to return to school while these measures are necessary.
